

The Break

4 Object Balls to hit cushion

If ball potted from break.O.K.

In off 1 visit. Ball off table 2 visits. Foul Break 2 visits

Ball potted from break. Player must nominate. If you nominate ball potted you are on that colour. If you nominate other colour you must pot one or opponent has open table.

Fouls

Foul shots can be played at any time. Object ball must stay where it has landed unless your opponent cannot pass both sides of his colour. If not he is in a foul snooker. He has the option of nominating one of your balls, which he must point to, or picking up the white. If he is still in a foul snooker behind the balk line he can nominate your ball or the black. He does not necessary have to hit these balls but it becomes his colour for that one shot. The cushion does not count in determining a foul snooker.

Jaw snooker has the same ruling as above

Push shots are allowed if played at speed.

Snooker's

If you snooker your opponent he must call "Total Snooker" This enables him to just play up to his colour. In normal play if a ball is not potted you must make a ball hit a cushion. If the player can see even a minute part of his ball he is not in a total snooker.

Touching Ball

Player can play away and hit his opponent's ball or the black but a ball must hit a cushion

Ball Dropping.

If a ball drops without being hit, no penalty. The ball is replaced where it lay. If it is your own colour, play on. This includes the black
